Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ the Lord,

Most of our newsletters follow a pattern very closely. This one is different, however, because it deals with a special project, so please read to the end.

Kenya

Brother Gene Vance was recently in touch with me about a minister in Kenya. They meet together through the Let's Start Talking program. Gene wanted to know if I could help with Bibles and I am happy to report, not only did we get Bibles for Edmond Anyango, but Brother Joseph Mukewa is helping him as well. They hope to meet in October. Gene and Cathy Vance have been long time friends and supporters of this ministry and I am thankful to Gene for letting me know about Edmond. In the area of Kenya where Edmond lives, Braille and audio Bibles are needed.

Nigeria

There is a minister in Nigeria, Osahon Amenaghawon, who delivers Bibles to rural villages in that nation. I was shocked to hear that devil worship is still quite popular in some areas of the country. Our goal is not only to provide him with various types of Bibles, but also to acquaint him better with New Testament Christianity. He goes into many rural areas where few roads are available. When we sent him funds for 100 Bibles, both in English and in the local dialect, he had to travel 4 hours each way to get them. Please keep this man and his work in your prayers.

Ireland

I have been speaking and teaching in several places here in Ireland. When I talked about the ministry to the Dublin church, 2 people requested large print Bibles, which have now been delivered. This year Ann could not come with me as she is helping to keep our 2-year-old granddaughter, Eloise, and our grandson, August, who was born on the 13th of June. Elise and Ross have been blessed with these 2 children. I am on my own, doing most cleaning and cooking. So far I have not poisoned anyone HA HA! I also got a request from a young man named Wisdom, who requests 7 study Bibles for a group that he is working with.

USA

We have had a request for a Braille Bible to be used for a little girl in the 4th grade. The answering machine is also bringing a good many requests for Bibles from various parts of the US.

SPECIAL PROJECT IN INDIA

You may remember that with God's help, you provided 2 vans for the regions of Mombasa and Mumias in Kenya. I am happy to report to you that brothers in Christ, Joseph Mukewa and Justus Ombucha, 78r9/ are making fantastic use of these vehicles. They often travel on difficult roads to get to Christians and also to deliver Braille and audio Bibles. Now, another project is needed for another van, by Brother Vijay Kumar. Vijay, his wife Swarupa, and children Timothy and Tabitha have a fantastic heart for the Lord! They conduct many Bible campaigns throughout and beyond the State of Andhra Pradesh, explaining why the scriptures are important and showing blind people how to use them. In July another blind man was baptized in to Christ. Several thousand blind people reside in

their community alone. The number of blind and vision impaired people coming to the congregation has produced an urgent need for a van. The following information is directly from Brother Vijay.

Why This Van is Needed:

1. To transport audio Bible units and Braille resources to remote areas.
2. To pick up and drop blind members for special spiritual gatherings and training.
3. To enable field visits and follow-up by our ministry volunteers.
4. To support medical aid trips and benevolent support to poor and visually impaired individuals.
5. To be used for gospel film ministry and camp work in collaboration with local churches.

I feel strongly that any congregation getting help will be much more involved if they have a part in helping. The church in India is going to raise \$2,500 for the van. My hope is that this ministry can provide between \$11,000 and \$12,000. This allows for tires, insurance, registration and other needs.

It is most important to keep in mind that our main goal is providing Bibles in many languages. I definitely do not want this van project to cut into ministry funding. If you know of any churches or individuals who can assist with this worthy project, please let us know. Please mark your gift plainly India VAN, to keep it separate from ministry work. God willing, we would like to have the van funded by the end of this year.
