


A Family You Can Call Your Own!



Please join us today in welcoming Glynn Langston to speak to us from God's word. Glynn is a native of Houston, Texas. Although blind since birth, Glynn has not let that keep him from his dynamic and adventurous lifestyle. Glynn made the Dean's list at Southwestern University in Georgetown, Texas; was named to Who's Who in American Colleges and Universities; graduated cum laude in 1971 with a degree in European History and Public Speaking; speaks fluent French, and is conversational in Russian, German, and Spanish. Glynn is an avid Ham Radio operator which has allowed him to be involved in several life-saving calls. For the majority of his life, Glynn has been a public speaker and teacher. Glynn has had audiences with kings (i.e. President De Valera of the Republic of Ireland) and has been a radio and television spokesman for the Irish National Council for the Blind. While serving as a missionary for over 22 years in European settings, Glynn has reached thousands of people, many visually impaired, with the Gospel message. Glynn and his family have committed themselves to the development of Insight International, a Braille Outreach Worldwide Ministry. It is Glynn's vision that free Biblical literature and audio cassettes for the visually impaired be available so that more souls can know and respond to the Lord. The need for this material is greater than any of us could possibly imagine.
