

C Good Morning Church Family! Today I would like to feature Evelyn Woolsey, a WH member since 1996.

R Evelyn was born the daughter of school teachers in a rural part of Texas. When they moved to Denton when Evelyn was a child, her father was introduced to the gospel by a fellow teacher and the family became faithful members of the church there. Her father passed on the gift of the gospel they had received, teaching many and bringing them to Christ. He went on to serve as an elder in the church in Sulphur, OK for many years.

R With this solid foundation of faith, Evelyn and her son moved to Texas and following the encouragement of former 2 WH members (now passed) she came to visit WH one Sunday and says when she walked in and met the members she knew that "this is my church, my home." Roger Omer approached her with a membership card and Evelyn has been a faithful member ever since. Even though limited by health issues in attendance since the pandemic, she still considers WH home and keeps up with the church.

After working for the insurance industry for a number of years and then the State of Texas Hwy Dept., Evelyn retired and enjoyed many trips to special places "quite different than back here in Texas." Favorite places to travel to were Alaska & Hawaii. Once, on an Alaskan cruise, she spent time on deck watching the Northern Lights when they were told to go below deck because of rough seas. The ship, she said began to have rough waves and hit small icebergs. While she and her friend were in their cabin, the ship struck a large iceberg, "shaking the whole ship and causing drawers to fall from the dresser." She was thinking "TITANIC!" but no stewards ever called for evacuation. The next morning, many passengers were hugging the rails on deck sea sick, including Evelyn's friend. Evelyn had taken the sea sickness pills the night before and was spared the experience. She mercifully shared her pills and her friend felt better soon. In spite of this experience, she still loves to travel to these special places.
