B Betty is a long time member of Western Hills. Her husband Aubrey (whom we all knew affectionately as "Red") served the church as a deacon faithfully for many years until his passing. Red was a deacon in charge of the benevolence program of the church. Red and Betty were very involved in helping raise funds for the Foster's Home for children in Stephenville; in fact, they started a church bowling league for area churches and all the funds raised were donated to the children's home. They found such a creative way to have fun fellowship with other Christians and serve the Lord all at the same time!

Red and Betty met on a blind date after one of Betty's friends "talked her into it." That date sparked a love that blossomed into a wedding 3 months later and a marriage that lasted for decades. The City has made us aware that Chapin Road will be under repair in phases for the replacement of a 16-inch cast iron water line between Cork Place and Renzel Boulevard. The first phase will be Westerly Road to Cimmaron Trail. The next is Cimmaron Trail to Bandera Road which will include our building. The third is Mary's Creek Drive to Morenci Drive, and lastly, Carman Drive to West Loop 820 South. Signs will detour individuals that are North of Chapin Road to Bangor Drive, Guadalupe Road and Camp Bowie West Boulevard. Detours will be also placed south of Chapin Road. The projected end date for the Chapin Road water line installation is August, 2022. We are bringing this to your attention so that you will be able to make the needed arrangements for arriving at the building.
