



Inhibiting The Spirit

One of the tremendous blessings we receive when we become children of God is the indwelling Holy Spirit. The scriptures teach that at the point of baptism, one receives the gift of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2.38; 5.32). The Holy Spirit comes into our hearts and takes up residence within us. Do you remember Paul saying that **"your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God?" (I Corinthians 6.19)**. The Holy Spirit leads us, strengthens us, sanctifies us, seals us, etc. (Romans 8.14; Ephesians 3.16; I Peter 1.2; Ephesians 1.13, 14). The Holy Spirit works within us and through us.

Have you ever considered that you could inhibit the Spirit from working within you? Do you remember Paul telling the Thessalonians, **"Do not quench the Spirit"** (I Thessalonians 5.19)? **"Quench"** means *"to stop doing it or not to have the habit of doing it."* There are two views as to what Paul actually meant. Some scholars believe that it refers to the non-miraculous measure of the Spirit given to all at baptism. When we participate in any immorality, anger, envy, or any course contrary to the teaching brought by the Spirit—then we are quenching the Spirit. Other scholars believe it was written specifically to those in Thessalonica who had received miraculous abilities from the laying on of Paul's hands and were smothering the work of the Spirit by not using their miraculous gifts. Whichever position one takes, there are other passages that teach we can **"Grieve the Holy Spirit of God"** through our actions as well as not participating in the works of God (Ephesians 4.30; Isaiah 63.10).

Are you inhibiting the Spirit from working within you? Are you grieving the Spirit by participating in things that are unholy? God gives us His Spirit to benefit us as we strive to live faithfully before Him. Thus, let the Spirit of God work in you and through you to do the will of the Lord our God. Gary
