R Charles was born in Ada, OK and lived there on a farm all the way through his high school graduation. He helped with the farm, was a member of FFA and a pitcher on the baseball team. (Charles, the Rangers need pitching help...just saying!) After graduation, Charles worked at a local bakery in Ada, until a friend encouraged him to go together and look for a job in Ft Worth. Charles took his \$22 and set off to Ft Worth and landed a job at Convair (predecessor to GD) as a machinist. Two years later, Uncle Sam called his name in the draft and Charles served as a MP in the Army, including one deployment to Germany. Charles came back to Ft Worth to work at GD, and eventually retired from Convair/GD/Lockheed after 44 years in the machine shop.



Lillian was born in Roff, OK and following her graduation from high school there, she worked with her sister in a local cement plant. Her sister was dating a boy that was a friend of Charles. During these years, Lillian taught Bible at several women's prisons, first in Ada and then in Ft Worth. Charles enjoyed visiting with shut-ins from church and taking them communion.

They have been blessed with two sons, three grandchildren, two great-grandchildren and two grand pups! In fact, they are pup-sitting for their grandson right now. They have travelled extensively, taking three cruises, and visiting much of the US. They also have a plum tree in their yard and shared some of the sweetest plums with our church family earlier this year.
