



Do I Really Love The Lost?

How often have you sung the song “*You Never Mentioned Him To Me*” with tears in your eyes? Maybe the tears arise because a loved one has passed into eternity unprepared to meet God. Or possibly, an opportunity to share the Gospel with one you deeply love passed and you didn’t take advantage of it. The song is designed to encourage us to freely share the Good News of salvation in Jesus Christ with everyone we meet. But often, it has a much more sobering influence because we realize our shortcomings in doing the Lord’s will.

Our Savior came into this world with the express purpose of seeking the lost (Luke 19.10). The Pharisees often condemned Jesus for associating with publicans and sinners (Matthew 9.10, 11; 11.19). Jesus justified His actions by saying, “***Those who are well have no need of a physician, but those who are sick***” (Matthew 19.12). Jesus, as the Great Physician, came to save the sin-sick soul. One cannot help but see His love and compassion for the lost. He described them as sheep without a shepherd (Matthew 9.36), and the lost sheep of the house of Israel (Matthew 15.24). Just as the shepherd left the ninety and nine to go in search of the one lost sheep, our Lord and Savior seeks the sinner out as well (Luke 15).

How do I achieve that same love and compassion for the lost as my Lord and Savior had? The apostle Peter tells us that Christ left us the perfect example and we should follow in His steps (I Peter 2.21). If we are going to grow more Christ-like daily, then we must learn to love the lost. How does such start? First, I must recognize the fact that everyone has a soul that will live for all eternity. There are only two places where one will spend eternity, in heaven above or in eternal damnation (Matthew 25.46). Understanding the glories of heaven and the horrors of hell should make me want to seek out the lost and tell them of Jesus. The sobering effect of the song “*You Never Mentioned Him To Me*,” is the fact that what if we are standing at the judgment bar of God and someone with whom we were acquainted and possibly even loved dearly turned to us in distress because we knew what could have saved his soul and never bothered to share it with him.



My love for the lost will come with my love for the Lord. If I truly love the Lord, then I will want to live for Him daily. Living for Jesus includes doing His will. His will is that we should go and teach the lost (Matthew 28.18-20). How can I claim to follow Him if I fail to do what He desires I do the most? Have you thought any more about the person you want to lead to Jesus this year? Maybe you could invite him/her to worship this Sunday?
