



R A member for over 20 years, Shirley was born in FW and graduated from
N Diamond Hill-Jarvis High School, where she enjoyed playing on the
E volleyball team. Her father, however, was stricken with a stroke when
R Shirley was only 5 years old, and she helped her mother as caretaker until her father passed when she was 15. (This type of commitment would characterize her life.)



During high school, she met Bob and invited him to a church youth function at the lake. They began dating and about 2 years later “we ran up to Oklahoma and got married.” Bob began having studies with Shirley’s brother-in-law, a preacher, and later gave his life to Christ as well. Bob and Shirley started a ceramic tile company which they operated for 40 years. During this time, they were blessed with 3 children and later, 6 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren. They also raised ostriches and sold eggs. Ask her how much they sold for! (I asked if they ever had one for breakfast, she said “Uh, no, that would be an expensive meal!) After Bob became ill, Shirley ran the business for a couple of years before turning the business over to their son. Bob and Shirley enjoyed having family outings to their house on Lake Granbury and loved fishing, gardening, and the party barge with the family. Shirley then worked as a Resolution Specialist for CGI until she retired for good. During these years she was caregiver to her husband, brother-in-law, and sister. She would cook a big meal for all of them almost every day until her brother-in-law and husband passed away. Shirley and Bob enjoyed 63 years of marriage together.

Since that time, Shirley has been joined here at WH by her other sister, Minnie Collins. Shirley has most definitely not retired from service for the Lord, she recently taught a 2-year-old Bible class and rarely misses a church function. They all say Shirley is an outstanding cook and enjoy their time together. I encourage you to reach out and get to know Shirley better, you’ll be blessed!
