Life for me has been challenging lately as my father passed away in October and we have moved in with my mother who has serious dementia and cannot live on her own. We'd like to keep her home as we did with my father. But, as you can imagine, I've been busy with these life changes.

In response to my personal situation, I have pushed all of my travel plans to 2026. So, as it stands now, I'll be travelling in January and all of March. You'll be hearing more about the upcoming trip in March in future e-newsletters.

As for Africa -- keep those brethren in your prayers. Insecurity is growing seriously in Nigeria with many being persecuted and hurting from Muslim extremism. We pray that the situation will improve soon but this hasn't slowed our guys down! They continue to press the Gospel on the African landscape. Keep them in prayers as they are on the front lines with the Gospel!

Three Prayer Points

1. **NIGERIA:** Nigeria is suffering severe insecurity in the northern parts of the country and it is starting to seriously bleed south -- where the majority of our brethren reside. Please keep them all in your prayers.
2. **TANZANIA** recently had an election to which the opposition political parties were not allowed to compete in the election. It seems that there was also post-election violence by the government forces on youth who were protesting the alleged electoral fraud. Now, coming up December 9th (which is Tanzania Independence Day) there are large protests planned and the stage seems to be set for more bloodshed and violence.

Tanzania is the country where my family and I live for 5 years. Please pray for this county and her beautiful people!

3. **CHINOMSO ARIMADU** is a good worker from Imo state, Nigeria, who was in a car accident on the way home from an evangelism outing. He suffered several injuries, including head and leg injuries. As I write this, he is still in the hospital and cannot be released until the bill is paid.






