She has hip surgery the following day but also suffered a stroke during that time. It has greatly affected her left side. With the holiday season, it seemed that I was having greater success getting a ROOT CANAL as opposed to getting my mother into a rehab facility. We took her home for about a week and then was able to, on Friday last week, get her into a rehab facility to try and recoup some of her abilities on her left side. We are still here and we will see how this all goes.

In connection to that, my next trip to Africa will be March 2nd. I will spend the entire month of March in Nigeria and perhaps a week in Ghana. Please pray for a successful trip but also the situation with my mother to be settled so I may travel.

As for Africa -- those brethren finished the year strong! Even despite desperate conditions and insecurity, they continue to preach the Gospel.

3. Divine Uche, a preacher in Mbutu, Nigeria, is working with a church that needs help with a roof. See the need below. You can also [CLICK HERE](#).




